ECOLOGY

The Poplar Creek Prairie, Carl Hansen Woods, and Schaumburg Road Grasslands consist of over 1000 acres of prairie, oak-hickory woodlands, marshes, ponds, a creek and a small lake. We have been restoring over 600 of those acres. An Illinois State Nature Preserve sits atop a rocky kame and is home to of over 100 species of native grasses and flowers.

RESTORATION

Through research and historical analysis, we have come to realize that land that was once farmed, grazed, or otherwise degraded will not be returned to good health without active restoration efforts. The Forest Preserves of Cook County support an active volunteer system with a proven track record of restoring and preserving their natural treasures. We aim to restore the ecosystem's original diversity of plants, birds, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, pollinators and other insects.
